- 1. Minutes from the February 4, 2013 meeting were approved.
- 2. Dean's report: Dean Wimbush reported on concerns of the sequestration on graduate education; the sequestration was scheduled to begin March 27. The sequestration may affect funding sources for doctoral students being supported by grants. Currently, there are 240 graduate students on the IU campus and 193 graduate students on the IUPUI campus. In other business, he reported that the Provost had established a committee to look at graduate education, more specifically, to look at ways to increase funding for students and decrease time to completion of degrees. He will be traveling to various graduate schools to learn how they can help assign staff to help. He also reported that he was working with others to determine how to implement transfer to the new university administrative (UA) structure.
